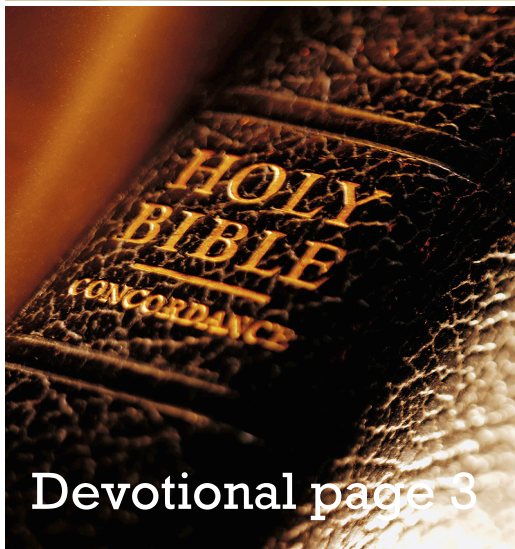

head in the same direction. We all have strengths and weaknesses. God has a way of using each and every one of us.

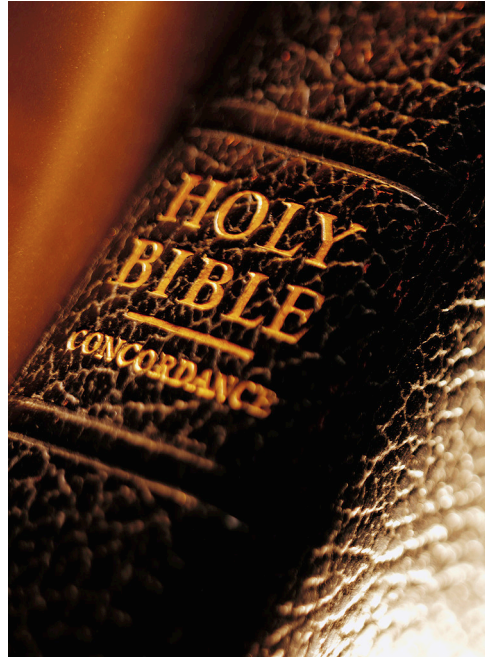
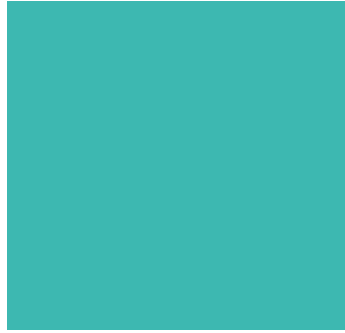
So before the train leaves the station I don't want you to miss out because you think you don't fit in. Everyone is welcome to come aboard! We need everyone's PARTICIPATION!

Devotion: God is good all the time.

Psalms 77: 7-9

“Will the Lord cast off for ever? And will he be favorable no more? Is his mercy clean gone for ever? Doth his promise fail for evermore?”

Pizza Dip:

A layered, hot cheesy dip with all of the great pizza flavors including pizza sauce, cheese, pepperoni, olives and green peppers.

4 oz. cream cheese, room temp

¼ cup sour cream

¼ cup mayo

½ cup mozzarella, grated

¼ cup Parmigiano reggiano, grated

1 cup pizza sauce

½ cup mozzarella, shredded

¼ cup Parmigiano reggiano, grated

2 oz. pepperoni, sliced

2 T green pepper, sliced

2 T black olives, sliced

Mix the cream cheese, sour cream, mayo, mozzarella and Parmigiano reggiano and spread it across the bottom of a pie plate. Spread the pizza sauce on top and sprinkle on the cheese, pepperoni, green pepper and olives. Bake at 350F until cheese is melted, bubbling and golden brown. About 20 mins. Serves 8
